



Lotus Creek Wind Farm Supplier Briefing

Your invitation

The Department of State Development, Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning and Vestas invite you to a supplier briefing event about the opportunities for regional businesses for the construction and operation of the Lotus Creek Wind Farm Project.

This briefing will feature presentations from Vestas who will provide information about the project status and timelines, work packages and how suppliers apply for those opportunities. The event will also provide an opportunity to network with Vestas and other suppliers.

The project

The Lotus Creek Wind Farm is around a \$1bn investment which will be located in the Isaac Regional Council area, approximately 20km west of St Lawrence in Central Queensland. It is within the Central Queensland Renewable Energy Zone, an area identified as optimal for new projects to support the state's renewable energy growth and clean energy transition.

The project which is expected to produce a maximum capacity of 341 megawatts of power, will comprise construction of 55 wind turbines and associated ancillary infrastructure. Construction is planned to commence in Q2 2023 and is expected to take 24-36 months to complete. The project is expected to create over 300 jobs during the peak construction period and approximately 15-30 jobs once operational.
